Candidate Curriculum 2025-2027

Candidacy Objectives:

- 1. Learn about CSJ history, consensus statement, acts of chapter and governance.
- 2. Participate in CSJ activities and ministries with Sisters, Consociates, Friends of St. Joseph, Agrégée, St. Joseph Worker Alum, and Partners in Mission.
- 3. Discern, personally and with community members, whether you are called to Consociate or Agrégée membership at this time:
- a. How would your life as a Consociate or Agrégée extend the CSJ mission of moving always toward profound love of God and neighbor without distinction (action and integration)?
- b. How does the spirituality of the CSJ charism inform and enrich your life?
- c. How does this community and your role in it assist in asking critical questions leading to action regarding issues that matter to you?
- d. Do you feel a sense of community and connection and how do you contribute to it?

Candidate Requirements:

	Attend candidate Sharing of the Heart gatherings.
□ everyc	Attend the Community-wide Mission and Values sessions. These gatherings are hybrid and open to one in the community but are of particular interest for Candidates.
	Attend Stirring the Fire Retreat in January 2026 and January 2027, if possible.
	Communicate with companion regularly, in person or by phone.
□ see ho	Meet with assigned contact person at least four times per year: October, December, February, April to w candidacy is going.
□ events	Document your participation in CSJ community activities (rituals, prayer services, meetings, social , etc).
	Attend 1 Community Assembly or Consociate Assembly over the course of candidacy.
□ organi	Visit 1 or more CSJ community ministries. This can be through Accola (www.accolamn.org) or other zations where CSJ community members serve.

□ Examp	Attend at least one event or gathering sponsored by the CSJ Justice Commission or Justice Office, ole: Prayer for the Signs of the Times (every second Wednesday of the month at 4:00pm).
	Interview/have focused conversations with 6 CSJ Community members you did not know prior to lacy. Focus on their story, on what drew them to CSJ, what keeps them here, what questions/critiques ave of the community.
□ A wide	Read <i>Eyes Open on a World</i> and 2 other books/articles/multimedia items on CSJ community or history. e variety of these items are available from the Candidate Resource Library in the Administration Center.
□ contac	In June 2026, create a reflection project on your candidacy so far and share with your companion and et team person. Some projects examples could include:
o iustice	Write about your evolving understanding/relationship with the values of community, spirituality, and at this point in your candidacy.
0	Create a piece of art to represent your candidacy journey so far. Painting, drawing, sculpture, collage, poetry, music
0	Find an existing piece of art that represents your candidacy journey so far, write a short piece to share his fits for you.
0	Any other idea you have that will help you in your discernment.
□ readin	Meet with your companion and contact team member in January/early February of 2027 and discuss ess for Consociate/Agrégée commitment.
□ Februa	Participate in a guided reflection time/retreat to discern making commitment in January/early ary of 2027. Date and process to be determined.
□ group	IF discerning Consociate commitment the following is required. IF discerning Agrégée, the Agrégée will help determine next steps.
0	Mid-Eahruary 2027 Consociate candidates write a letter to members of the Province Leadership

- Mid-February, 2027, Consociate candidates write a letter to members of the Province Leadership Team and Council expressing your desire to make Consociate commitment. The names of these representatives will be made available to you. The letter is to include the following:
- why you desire to be a Consociate;
- the ways you express the mission of love of God and love of neighbor without distinction;
- the ways you participate in the community; the gifts that you bring;
- and what you hope to give to and receive from the community.
- Attend Province Council meeting in Spring (TBD) to talk about contents of your letter, meet with members of the Council and Consociate Community.
- Attend Welcome and Commitment Ritual (and rehearsal, if necessary), May 1, 2027
